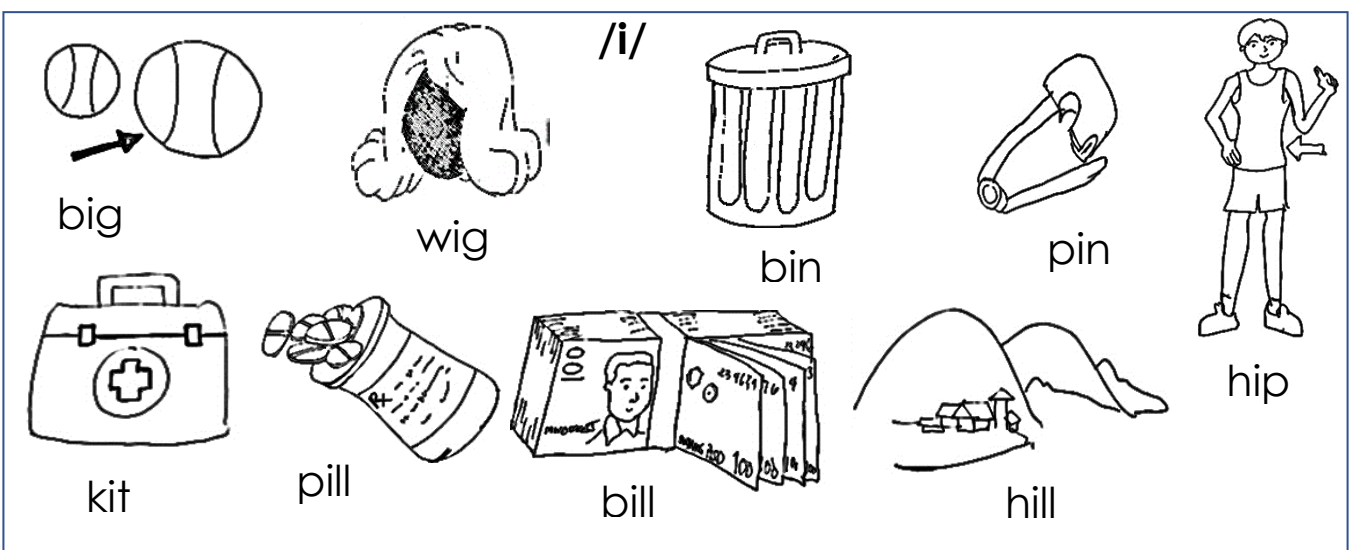
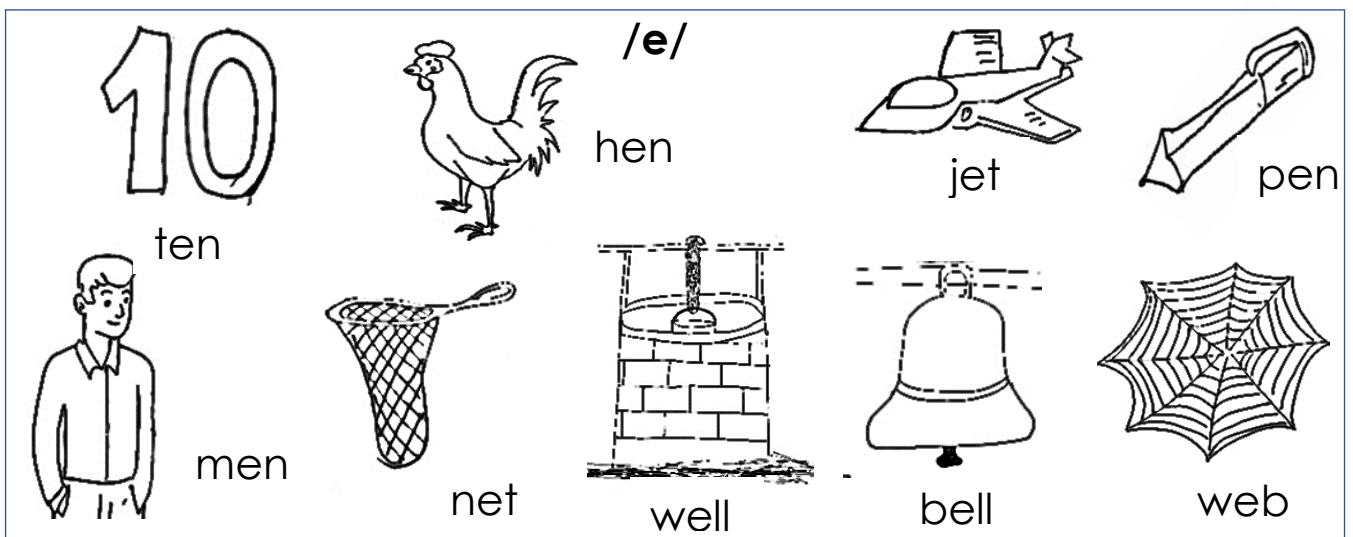
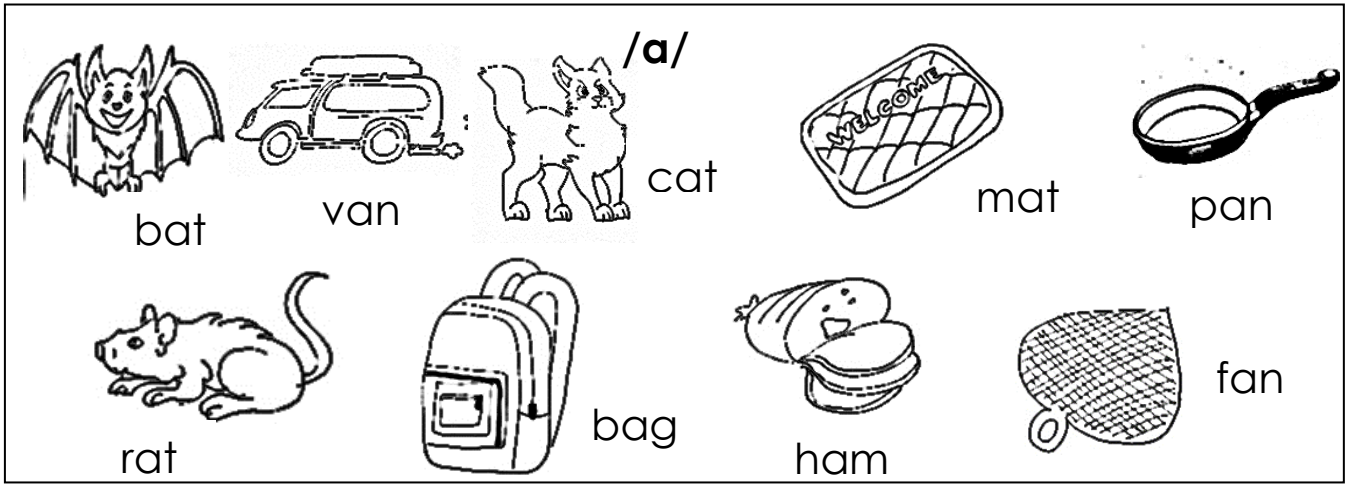


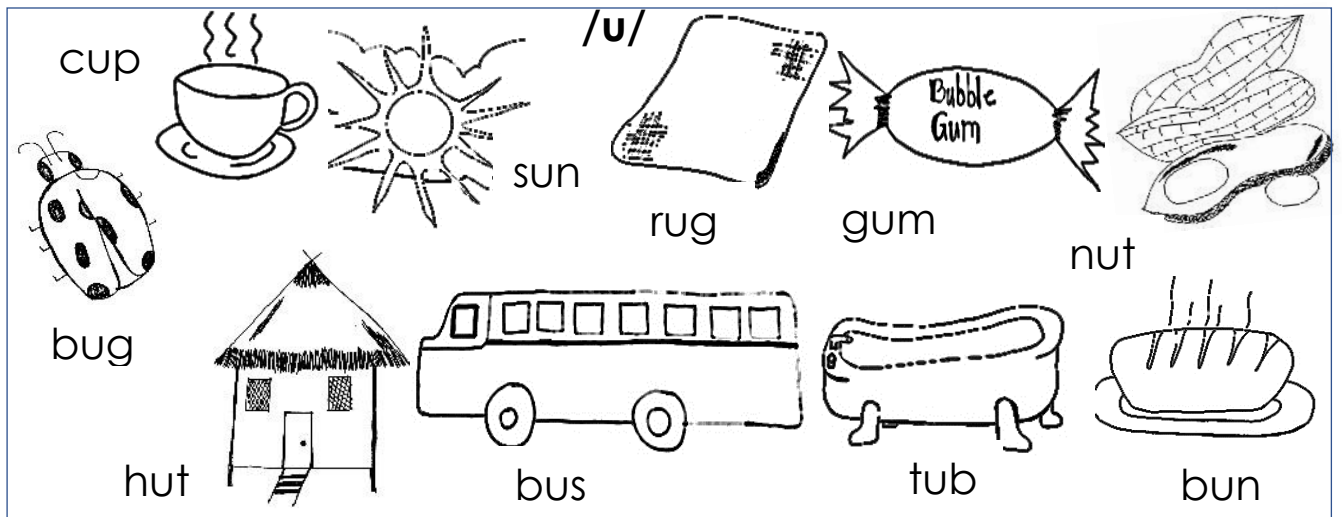
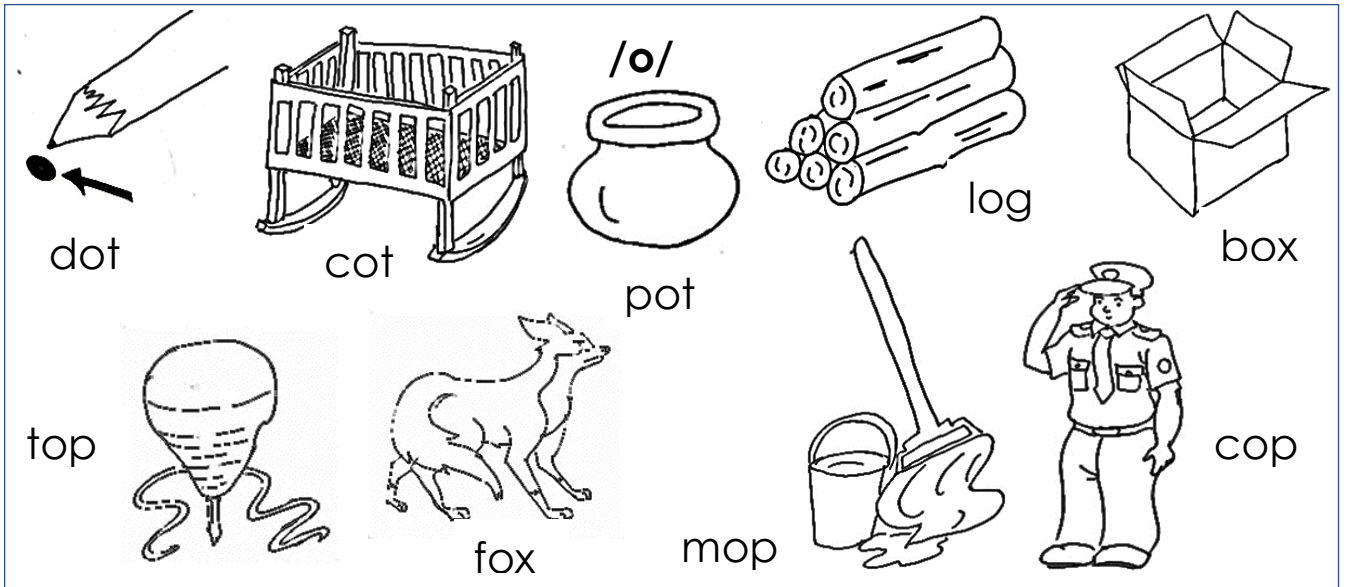
## What is it
