


How are you children?





What is It

The first column in the **What's New** is called Phrases. **Phrases** are group of words that does not express a complete thought. The second column is called sentence. **Sentence** are group of words that expresses a complete thought. Short e, a, i, o, and u are words with medial vowel sounds like cub, hot, tub, pig, hen etc. The third coulumn is a **Short Story**. Below are examples of phrases and sentences consisting of short e, a, i, o, and u.


