









What is it

A **map** is a representation of a real place. It helps you find where places are located. Α compass rose tells directions on a map. East (E), West (W), North (N), and South (S) are the directions also called as primary **Cardinal Directions**. East and west are opposite directions. North and south are opposite directions. The four secondary directions are northeast. northwest.


southeast and southwest. Secondary direction is also called as **intermediate directions** wherein it helps locate places between the cardinal directions.






