What is it?

Multimedia is a measure that uses a combination of different content forms such as text, audio, images, animation, video and interactive content. Multimedia contrasts with media that use only computer displays such as text-only or traditional forms of printed or hand-produced material.

Multimedia can be recorded and played, displayed, interacted with or accessed by information content processing devices, such as computerized and electronic devices. It can also be a part of a live performance.

5 Elements of Multimedia


1. Text

ROAD SAFETY Basic Intermediate Advanced
First, before crossing the road, make sure you look to your left, to your right and then left again.

- A broad term that contains words to express something.
- Text is the most basic element of multimedia.
- A good choice of words could help convey the intended message to the users (keywords).
- A text is used in contents, menus, and navigational buttons.

2. Graphic

- Two-dimensional figure or illustration
- Could be produced manually (by drawing, painting, carving, etc.) or by computer graphics technology.
- Used in multimedia to show more clearly what a particular information is all about (diagrams, picture).
- A picture that expresses a thousand words.

3. Audio

- Produced by vibration, as perceived by the sense of hearing.
- In multimedia, audio could come in the form of speech, sound effects and also music score.

4. Animation

- The illusion of motion created by the consecutive display of images of static elements.
- In multimedia, animation is used to further enhance/enrich the experience of the user to further understand the information conveyed to them.

- Video is more towards photo realistic image sequence/ live recording as in comparison to animatio.
- Video also takes a lot of storage space. So plan carefully before you are going to use it.

When you are reading, sometimes it can help to have pictures, videos, or sounds to help you understand the text.

Multimedia elements can help readers clarify meaning while reading in many ways. Visuals or interactive elements help the reader understand the vocabulary being used in the text. For instance, if you didn't know about kryptonite, a picture of the rock and what it does to Superman would let you know that it hurts them.


