
This module is made for you to understand the importance of writing a paragraph. It provides you with different perspective of solutions to a problem. It marks on our mind "In every problem there is always a solution".


Both reading books at home and going on vacation are fun. Through reading, you meet new people and see new places at less expense. When you don't feel like interacting with your new friends you just stop reading.
