

# IMPORTANT DETAILS IN EXPOSITORY TEXT

Expository text is a text that provides facts and educationally explains ideas. It is typically found in newspapers, instructional manuals, encyclopedias, cookbooks, and other resources that provide us with information.

## The Dolphins

Dolphins are highly social animals. But are dolphins' fish? No. Dolphins are mammals just like me and you. Dolphins breathe air, give birth to baby dolphins, also known as calves, nurse their babies with milk, and have hair at some point in their life. They have a constant body temperature, which means they're warm blooded animal.

Unlike fish, which are non-mammalian animals, dolphins do not possess gills, so they must come to the surface of the water to breathe. The blowhole on top of their head acts as a "nose", making it easy for the dolphin to surface for catching breath.

Expository texts are written in a paragraph which composed of the main idea and important details.


