

# What I Need to Know

If you are looking to talk about how often something happens, then you will need to employ the use of an adverb of frequency. These can let our learners know that an event takes places weekly, hourly, monthly and a variety of other adverbs of frequency.

Knowing that adverbs of frequency is a great way to be able to further explain a situation within conversation, as well as adding a whole host of new words to your vocabulary.

In this module, the learners should be able to:

1. Compose clear and coherent sentences using grammatical structure Adverbs of frequency. (EN6G-Ig-4.4.1)







These words are adverbs of frequency. **Adverb of frequency** describes how often an action is done.

ADVER	ADVERBS OF FREQUENCY			
Adverbs	Examples			
Always	She always goes to church to pray.			
Usually	They usually quarrel.			
Normally	I normally go to the gym.			
Often	They often go out for dinner.			
Sometimes	I sometimes go with my husband.			
Occasionally	I occasionally eat junk food.			
Seldom	I seldom read the newspaper			
Rarely	I rarely go to cinema			
Never	I never go to the cinema. I don't like			
	it.			

These are the list examples of adverb of frequency.

More adverbs of frequency

weekly regularly annually Almost normally monthly daily constantly frequently

#### Simple rules for adverb of frequency.

- Use adverbs of frequency to discuss how often something happens. Example. He is **rarely** late for work.
- Adverbs of frequency are often used to indicate routine or repeated activities, so they often used with the simple present tense.
   Example: I usually walk to work.
- If a sentence has only one verb, place the adverb of frequency in the middle of the sentence so that it is positioned after the subject but before the verb. Example: My father **occasionally** reads books.
- When a sentence contains more than one verb, place the adverb of frequency before the main verb.

Example: Mary often waters and cultivate her plants in the garden.




