"The Swing Festival" Dr. Celestina N. Jalandoni

This festival is held in <u>India</u> after the <u>hot summer months</u> and the monsoon rains cool the air. Their fields are green with millet and sugarcane. The villages are in very good spirit because they look forward to a good harvest.

<u>In the evening</u> before the festival, the young men go out to the common lands of the <u>village</u> to look for trees where they can hang their swings. Some men mark the trees to prevent competitors from fighting over the use of the trees. The young men set up the swings at <u>one o'clock</u> the following <u>morning</u> but the swinging is done <u>later</u> in the day.

The children start swinging <u>early</u>, while the men are <u>in the fields</u> and the women are <u>at home</u> making cakes and rice puddings.

<u>At noon time</u> they put on their best clothes and walk singing in family groups <u>towards</u> the trees where they swing facing each other with two others at the back to push them. After the swinging the family goes home to eat their festival meal together.



Adverb of Place and Time

Adverbs may indicate time, place, degree, manner, affirmation or negation. Adverbs of time tell us when something happened or when someone did something. It may also tell us the duration of the action. ; Some examples are: later, someday, last night, soon, now, today, and etc. On the other hand, adverbs of place answer the question where. It describes where something happens. Example: up, down, here, there, beside, beneath, under, and above.
