

Annex 3: Guidelines for Presenters of ZamPen Innovation Summit 2024

- 1. All Schools Division Offices shall submit their top 3 entries to present on the following innovation themes: (1) Research-Based Innovations, (2) Technological Innovations, (3) Teaching and Learning Innovations, (4) People Development Innovations, and (5) Community and Partnership Innovations.
- 2. Innovations with multiple proponents or authors shall be represented by only one main author as presenter for ZamPen Innovation Summit 2024.
- 3. SDOs shall submit the innovation manuscript on or before September 3, 2024, through this link: https://tinyurl.com/ZamPen-Innovation-Files, using this file name format: SDO Name_Family Name of Presenter_Title of Innovation.
- 4. The innovation manuscript shall be written in 1000 to 2000 words (excluding the Appendix) with the following side headings:

I. Title and Name of Proponent/s

- -Present a concise title that captures the essence of innovation.
- -Indicate the name of the proponent/s or authors and specify the presenter for the ZamPen Innovation Summit 2024 if there are multiple authors.

II. Rationale

- -Identify the problem or need that the innovation is designed to address.
- -Explain briefly its significance and relevance.

III. Objectives

- -Specify the innovation goal to address the identified need or problem.
- -Articulate objectives according to SMART principles.

IV. Innovation Description

- -Describe innovation in detail.
- -Explain the method used and how it works.
- -Highlight its unique features and benefits.

V. Target Beneficiaries

-Identify who would benefit from the innovation.

VI. Implementation Plan

- -Outline the innovation development.
- -Describe the implementation strategy.
- -Include milestones, resources, and timelines.

VII. Innovation Impact

- -Discuss the positive outcomes and impact on users, stakeholders, and the organization.
- -Quantify impact or benefits whenever possible using data or metrics.

VIII. Next Steps

-Provide clear direction on what needs to be done next to achieve innovation milestones.

- 5. The manuscript must be in pdf format, written in Bookman Old Style, font size 11, single spacing, 1-inch margin on all sides, and using an A4 paper size.
- 6. ZamPen Innovators shall set up their innovation exhibit at the venue using a 2 x 5 ft tarpaulin poster with a portable standee and other eye-catching visuals, infographics, or product demos to communicate the innovation effectively. The exhibit should be minimalist and clutter-free.
- 7. The Innovation Presentation and Panel Discussion shall be done by group, with two break-out sessions per innovation theme: (1) Research-Based Innovations, (2) Technological Innovations, (3) Teaching and Learning Innovations, (4) People Development Innovations, and (5) Community and Partnership Innovations.
- 8. Presenters shall submit four (4) hard copies of the innovation manuscript at the venue in an A4-red folder to be distributed to the panel.
- 9. Presenters are allotted 5-10 minutes per presentation during the breakout sessions. They shall present not more than 12 slides PowerPoint with the following contents: (1) Title and Author, (2) Rationale, (3) Objectives, (4) Innovation Description, (5) Target Beneficiaries, (6) Implementation Plan, (7) Innovation Impact, and (8) Next Steps.
- 10. Panel members are given 5-10 minutes for 'question and answer' for every presenter. They are expected to ask specific questions and clarifications related to the innovation so that presenters can respond well. They are also expected to provide insights and recommendations constructively.
- 11. Further, the panel members shall also rate the presentation based on the criteria/scoring guide for the following:

Part I. Content of the Innovation Manuscript (70 points)

- Innovation and Creativity
- Relevance and Significance
- Clarity and Comprehensibility
- Development and Implementation
- Impact and Benefits

Part II. Innovation Exhibit (15 points)

- · Content and Innovation
- Presentation and Communication
- Poster Mechanics and Appearance

Part III. Innovation Presentation and Panel Discussion (15 points)

- Presentation and Communication
- Mastery of the Content
- · Ability to Answer Questions and Receptiveness to Comments and Suggestions
