

CAREER READINESS EDUCATION CARAVAN YEAR 3

- 1. The **Career Readiness Education Caravan Year 3** aims to establish partnerships with various stakeholders to benefit our Grade 10 and 12 learners. It seeks to equip them with knowledge about the different senior high school tracks and strands, as well as their corresponding curriculum exits: Employment (*Trabaho*), Higher Education (*Kolehiyo*), and Entrepreneurship (*Negosyo*).
- 2. The Caravan will take place on October 1, 2024, at the Dipolog City Sports Complex Gym, Olingan, from 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM.
- 3. Participants in this activity include **thirty Grade 10 students per school** and **all Grade 12** from SY 2024-2025. The Teacher Career Advocates will act as the chaperones for Grade 10 students, while the school head will assign teaching or non-teaching personnel as chaperones for Grade 12 students. **A ratio of 1 chaperone per 50 students must be observed.**
- 4. The school head must ensure continuity of learning for the classes of teachers serving as chaperones during the event. It is recommended to provide Learning Activity Sheets for students to complete during their scheduled class time.
- 5. Learner-participants are encouraged to bring their own snacks, lunch, and refillable water canteens or tumblers. The use of single-use plastics is strongly discouraged. Food booths from vendors like Julie's Bakeshop, DC Cafe, and Cheesemo will also be available at the venue, offering affordable menu options.
- 6. See attached Enclosure 1 for the list of members of the Working Committees. All members are requested to attend the meeting on September 24, 2024, at 1:00PM at DepEd Dipolog Training Center.
- 7. YES-O and SSLG student officers are requested to bring their own garbage bags and ensure the CLAYGO (Clean As You Go) principle is consistently observed throughout the event. A designated area for dropping off garbage bags will be announced on the day of the event.









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- 8. Each class adviser must ensure that all students are fully registered for the event. Complete registration includes filling out the Attendance Sheet and submitting a duly signed Parent's Consent. Please refer to Annexes A and B for the Attendance Sheet and Parent's Consent, respectively. Class advisers are required to prepare two copies of the Attendance Sheet: one copy is to be submitted to the school's Teacher Career Advocate, who will collate and forward it to the event organizers on the day of the event. Failure to submit the Attendance Sheet will result in denied entry. Class advisers are also responsible for the safekeeping of the Parent's Consent.

- 10. Expenses incurred by the school personnel during the Caravan will be charged against school MOOE subject to existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 11. Moreover, school heads should make the necessary arrangements and preparations for the logistics of their learners, ensuring that parents acknowledge their shared responsibility in this matter. School heads are also encouraged to coordinate with and seek assistance from their respective Barangay Local Government Unit (BLGU).
