## ADMINISTRATION OF THE PREPARATION OF EXAMINATION SUITE – NATIONAL ACHIEVEMENT TEST (PES-NAT)

- 1. Pursuant to **DepEd Order No. 55, s. 2016**, entitled "Policy Guidelines on the National Assessment of Student Learning for the K to 12 Basic Education Curriculum," the Department of Education, through the Bureau of Education Assessment, will conduct Exit Assessments to be administered in Grades 6, 10, and 12.
- 2. The Schools Division Office will administer the Preparation of Examination Suite-National Achievement Test (PES-NAT) for Grade 6, 10, and 12 learners. This initiative aims to provide guidance on the context and features of technology-enhanced examination environments, bridge the digital divide, and determine if learners are meeting the learning standards of the Elementary, Junior High School, and Senior High School curriculum.
- 3. The Preparation of Examination Suite-National Achievement Test (PES-NAT) will commence on October 11, 2024, during the schedule of the National Mathematics Program (NMP) for Grades 6 and 10, and every Friday for Grade 12. The test will be administered weekly through an online platform using a Google link.
- 4. The subjects to be tested are English, Science, Mathematics, Filipino, and Araling Panlipunan. There will be 5 items per learning area, with a total of 25 items.
- 5. The scope of the examination follows the Most Essential Learning Competencies (MELCS) for each quarter.
